Landscaping & Irrigation

If necessary, please address the area around your air conditioning unit on the side of your home. Our documents read as follows: "All air conditioning units shall be shielded and hidden so that they shall not be visible from any street or adjacent property." Our landscape company has prepared a proposal for the residents of Georgetown. It is the homeowners responsibility to schedule and pay for this work to be done. Contact Steve Mandel for more information.

We are asking all residents not to interfere with the workers that are on our property. **Do not ask for special favors or specific work at your home.** They have a schedule that has to be followed. The workers have been instructed not to respond to anyone. We ask for your cooperation. If there are any landscape concerns, please contact the Property Manager's Office at 954-718-9903 and report the problem.

The replacement of the ficus hedges at our entrance has been completed.

If any one is experiencing irrigation concerns, please make sure you call the property managers office as soon as it is discovered and indicate where the problem exists. A work order for the repair will be made and the work will be scheduled

Over time, homeowners have the responsibility of refreshing landscaping. It is important to make sure that your replacements are planted properly and are given proper attention. Flower beds should contain mulch or stones and a border material to prevent the mulch or stones from spreading onto the grass. Additionally, the area around any trees on your property should have mulch, stones or plantings around it and have a border material to keep the material separated from the grass. Our landscape company will not be responsible for plants that are not properly planted in the ground by the homeowner or other contractors.
