#### Dear Georgetown Residents,

We hope that our Georgetown residents are settling in to 2023. Your board of Directors has been very busy continuing to work with our contractors and property manager to address important issues that arise. We would like to thank the many homeowners who have and are continuing to improve your homes by adhering to our documents and performing needed upgrades to your homes. It is vitally important that all residents be proactive in recognizing that pressure cleaning of your roofs, driveways and exterior of your home is essential. Flower beds and plantings do not last forever and need replacing as time goes by. It is your responsibility to notify the management company, CCM, of any problems that you are experiencing with irrigation or land-scaping or coach lighting. The first step is to fill out a Maintenance repair form (online) and send it to them. To obtain the form, go to eagle-trace/Georgetown. Click maintenance Repair Form, fill out the form and send it to CCM. Without this form, CCM will not know a problem needs attention.

Also, please make sure when planning exterior changes to your property, (new garage door, front door, painting, roof replacement), an ARC form is completed and approved by the Board <u>prior to the work beginning.</u> This form is also on line.

#### Important reminders:

Trash pick up and recycling materials are picked up on Tuesday.

Place your bins at the curbside Monday evening.

Trash and bulk items are picked up on Friday.



Place all bins and bulk items out on Thursday evening.

If, for some reason, your items are not picked up, call Waste Pro at 954-282-6800 and let them know the address where the items were left.

Trash bins should be stored where they are not visible. If they are placed on the side of your home, they should be placed behind a hedge or wall.

Please make sure you make your <u>new monthly payments on the 1st day of</u> <u>each month.</u> If you wait until the 15th, it may cause a late fee to be added to your payment. If you are experiencing any difficulty with this procedure, please contact CCM at 954-718-9903. Please ask for Tara if you are unable to reach someone.
